I am writing to provide an update on changes for the Term 3 student reports at Mortlake P-12 College. The Department of Education and Training has adjusted the expectations of Student Reports for Semester 1 & 2 in recognition of the transition to remote and flexible learning during Term 2 & 3.

While our school has continued to deliver its teaching and learning program and monitor the achievement and progress of each student, there have been some unprecedented changes to our usual program.

At Mortlake P-12 College we know it is vital to involve students and their parents/carers in learning. This process includes providing reports on student learning.

Mortlake P-12 College will provide a written report for the parent/carer of each student enrolled at the school for Semester 2 (end of Term 4) as well as a progress report for Term 3. The end of semester 2 reports will include more detailed information on student achievement for each curriculum area taught, however, there are some changes from our usual Term 3 progress reports.

Our Term 3 progress report is a brief report focussing on the student's attitude towards learning marked on a 5 point scale against Effort & Attitude, Organisation & Engagement in online forums.
